



Second Quraan Competition, Ramadan 1439 AH

The Islamic Society of Central Pennsylvania is organizing the second Quraan competition during the holy month of Ramadan 1439 AH. The primary purpose of this competition is to promote the connection of the Muslim community, children, youth and adults, with the holy Quraan. Furthermore, the competition provides a platform for everyone to get to know more about the miracles of the Quraan, and improve their recitation skills. As an added value of the competition, we hope that this would bring the community together during the holy month of Ramadan.

Categories:

Everybody is welcome to participate. Participants are going to be divided into two categories with different assignments according to their age.

- Adults: Tajweed / Recitation.

- Children: Memorization.

For adult participants, the competition is recitation-based. There are assigned judges who will be available at the mosque in specific announced time slots to evaluate and correct the recitation of each participant and then approve it based on specific criteria. Recitation begins from Surat Al Bakarah. All participants will always have access to real-time updates of the overall competition results so that everyone would be able to compare his performance to others. The participants are going to be ranked according to the number of recited pages approved by the judges. Participants ranking first to third are going to be announced on a weekly basis. By the end of Ramadan, the one with the highest number of approved recited pages would be declared the winner.

For children, the competition is memorization-based. One Surah will be assigned to be memorized. Each participant will do recitation from memory (Tasmiee) on multiple occasions and judges will be responsible for evaluations, and will give an individual feedback for every participant including tips on how to improve.

Prizes:

Prizes will be given to the participants ranking first to third in each category by the end of Ramadan. Prizes will be distributed in the Eid prayer.

Registration:
